This week our children have been learning about staying safe when travelling to and from school.

- ⚠ Bar Lane & Percy Street pedestrian crossing
- ⚠ Bar Lane directly outside school

We've also raised concerns about children doing wheelies in the road while cycling to school — please remind your child to stay safe and sensible at all times. Together, let's keep everyone safe!

Miss Johnson has also written to the local council asking for an urgent review into a pedestrian crossing on Bar Lane.
