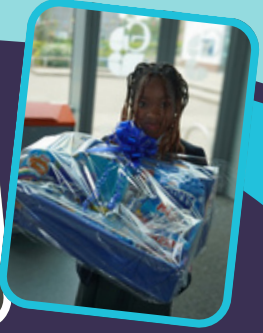

## Safeguarding

This week in safeguarding, our children have been learning about the risks of the 18+ platform Omoggle.

Omoggle is a random video chat website that connects users via webcam with complete strangers for live, one-to-one chat. It then "rates" user's appearances using AI and declares a winner using mansphere type language.

It is unregulated and not moderated, therefore posing a serious safeguarding risk. Its use of AI face analysis means children's images or video could be captured and stored without consent, increasing the risk of misuse. This can make children more vulnerable to grooming, coercion and blackmail if images are shared or manipulated.
