# Appropriate clothing for cold weather

As we are now experiencing some extremely cold weather, I'd like to remind our children of that which is appropriate with regards to cold weather clothing.

I would like to thank all parents and carers for their support in advance. Uniform has improved significantly over time here at Ellis Guilford School; made possible by the continued partnership between parents/carers and the school.

In all weathers (except for severe weather when individual arrangements will be shared), all children are expected to wear full school uniform to school.

#### **Expected uniform:**

- EGS Blazer
- EGS Tie
- White Shirt
- Grey/Black Trousers/Skirt (Grey only for Year 7)
- Plain navy knitted V-neck jumper (Years 7-11)
- Plain black knitted V-neck jumper (Years 8-11 only)

### Footwear:

Although in particularly icy conditions, children may choose to wear alternative footwear on their travel to school, children are expected to be in their usual school shoes whilst on school site. School shoes must be plain black and polishable.

### Coat:

It is strongly advised that all children bring a coat to school during periods of cold weather. Much of our school site is outdoors and children need to move between buildings during the day.

Hoodies and hooded jumpers are not permitted on school site. All coats must be worn on top of the EGS blazer and not instead of.

## Hats, Scarves and Gloves:

It is strongly advised that all children wear additional items when outdoors in the cold weather. These may include woolly hats, scarves and gloves.



Caps are not permitted (unless worn during the summer in intense heat). Scarves worn for cold weather must not cover the face. Snoods are not permitted.
