Reducing the spread of winter illnesses

As is typical at this time of year, we are seeing an increasing amount of winter illnesses in and around our local area.

In order to keep our children and staff as healthy as possible during this season, we are encouraging the following in school to reduce the spread of illness:

- Catch It, Kill It, Bin It following NHS guidance regarding this simple process. All classrooms have tissues available for children should they require them.
- Regular Hand Washing Children are encouraged to wash their hands regularly during social times, before eating and after using toilet facilities.
- Regular and thorough cleaning Our cleaning team are regularly cleaning door handles and other high-traffic areas to ensure these remain clean at all times.
