Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 11 Arrangements – Friday 22nd May and Post Half-Term

As we move further into the examination period, we would like to share the arrangements for Year 11 children on Friday 22nd May. On Friday, the day will begin with our **EGScellence EGStravaganza assembly** during tutor time, where we will take the opportunity to recognise and celebrate the EGScellent efforts of Year 11 this half term.

Periods 1 and 2:

Children who still have remaining exams in their option subjects will attend their normal lessons. Children who have completed exams in their option subjects will instead attend **Maths and Science masterclasses**. This will provide beneficial additional intervention ahead of their upcoming exams in these subjects.

Periods 3 and 4:

All Year 11 children will take part in **Maths and Science masterclasses** to support their preparation for upcoming exams.

Period 5:

We will be holding a wellbeing hour for all Year 11 children, to recognise their significant efforts throughout the exam season so far. During this time, there will be a “Spin the Wheel” rewards activity with many prizes up for grabs. We have also organised for an ice cream van to be on site, and all children will receive an ice cream free of charge in recognition of these efforts.
