SAFEGUARDING - HSB in Education

This week in safeguarding training, we have explored the important topic of harmful sexual behaviour (HSB) among children and young people.

The tragic case of Sarah Everard in 2021 shocked the UK and was a reminder of the wider societal issues around violence against women and girls, and why schools must play a proactive role in prevention and education.

We have trained our children to be able to identify types of harmful sexual behaviour and how to report it - in person or anonymously.
