Dear Parent/Carer

October Half-Term Study Sessions

As part of our package of support for Year 11 pupils this year, I am pleased to inform you that we are offering a significant number of additional study sessions over the half term holiday. These are particularly important as on the week beginning 11 November, the first Pre-Public Examinations will start, which is a critical moment in year 11 and will give an indication as to how pupils are performing in the run up to the summer exams. All pupils must take these exams as seriously as they would the real exams, as should the worst happen and exams are cancelled, the exam boards will potentially use this data to help them calculate grades.

We are endeavouring to offer as much help and support to pupils as possible, and the study sessions over the holiday are another way we are able to offer additional learning time. It is therefore highly recommended that pupils attend the study sessions, where offered.

Each study session will run for two and a half hours. The morning sessions will start at 10am, and the afternoon sessions will start at 1pm. If pupils are attending a session, they will need to be registered onsite at the beginning of each session. Pupils must enter school through main reception and sign in, then make their way to the correct venue. Unfortunately, there will be no lunch facilities available, so if pupils are attending both morning and afternoon sessions, they must provide their own lunch. Pupils are not expected to wear school uniform when they are in school over half-term.

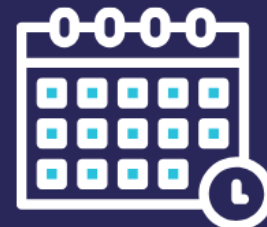

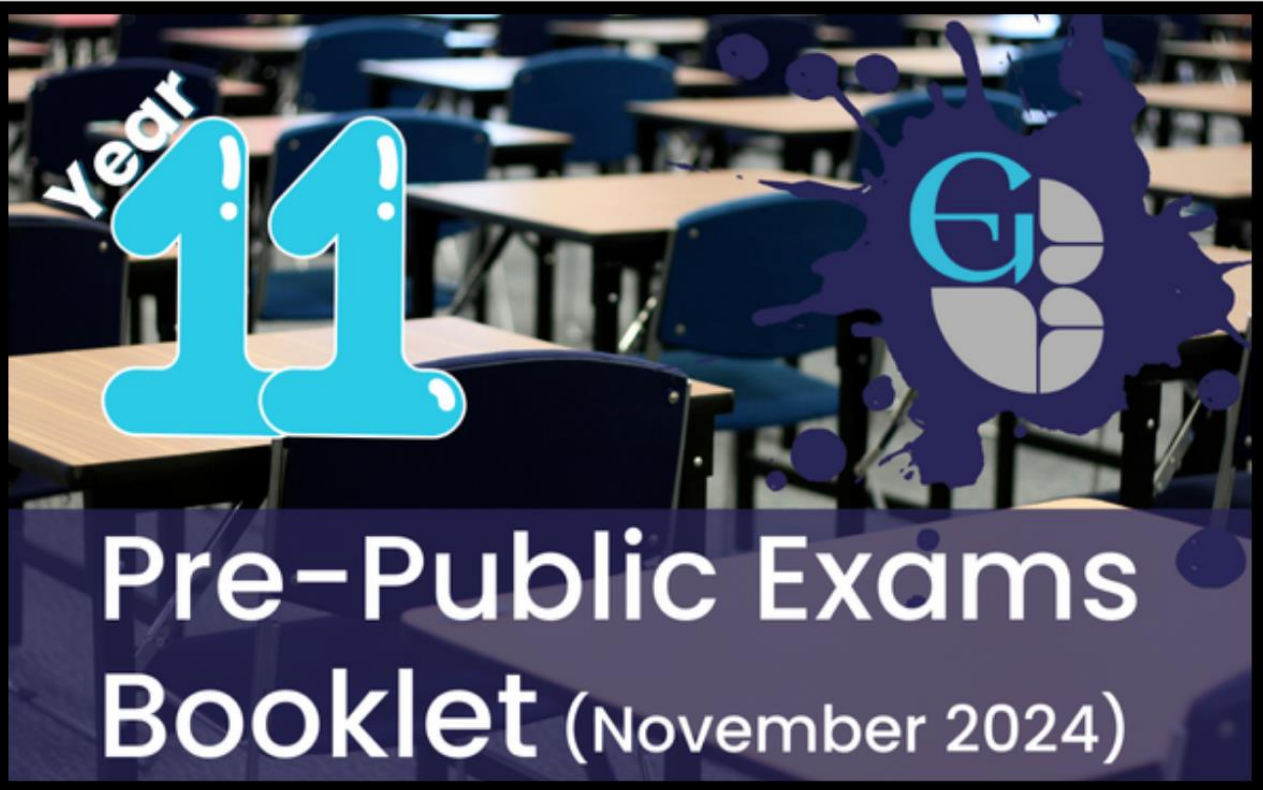
