Ellis Guilford School EGSpectations

Attendance: Between now and the Christmas break, we are encouraging children to hit a 100% attendance target. This includes 35 days of school and we will be issuing weekly and half-termly reward opportunities for children who meet this target.

Punctuality: All children are expected to arrive at school by 8.35am. This is a basic EGSpectation here at Ellis Guilford School. Line-ups and tutor time are crucial for children to receive information for the day ahead and to start their day with positive recognition.

Uniform: A reminder that plain navy v-neck knitted jumpers can be worn with a blazer. They must not be worn without a blazer. Skirts must be knee-length or just above the knee. Trousers must be formal school trousers.

Coats can be worn but they must be removed before entering classrooms.

PE Kit: Please find attached guidance about our school PE kit, and a reminder about what children are permitted to wear for PE.

Jewellery: A reminder please that the only jewellery permitted in school are stud earrings in the ears, and one nose stud. Any other jewellery is not permitted in school.

PE Uniform

- We have the highest EGSpectations regarding uniform. This includes PE kit!
- Most children wear our PE uniform well in every lesson
- After half term, we will be changing the way that we tackle issues where children arrive without PE uniform.

PE kit can be black OR navy this year. As of September 2026, all PE kit must be navy.



Official EGS PE kit;

- PE T-shirt (black or navy)
- Socks
- Trainers
- Black or navy shorts, joggers or leggings





Additional **** Layers in Cold Weather

No items of school uniform are permitted to be worn for PE. This includes the navy V neck jumper. No sweatshirts, hoodies, jackets or coats are allowed to be worn for PE.

Children are permitted to wear;

- EGS official tracksuit top (£6.99/£7.99 from www.justschoolwear.co.uk)
- Plain black/navy long sleeve top can be worn underneath the EGS PE T shirt
- Gloves and woolly hats are permitted to be worn in cold conditions





If your child has an issue with their PE uniform, please send a note in to school stating the reason why they do not have their kit, so that an adjustment can be made for that week so that they can borrow kit.

- All children should have full PE uniform every lesson
- If a child does not have full PE uniform:
 - First time in a half term = Warning
 - Second time in a half term (and any further incidents of no PE uniform) = 30minute
 Reflection after school

Children who do not have PE uniform must borrow spare kit. If a child refuses to borrow kit, they will be unable to take part in the lesson and will receive an SLT Reflection for 60minutes at the end of the school day.
