Dear Year 11 Parents/Carers,

### **YEAR 11 FINAL EXAMS AND LEAVERS ARRANGEMENTS**

Firstly, I would like to thank you for your continued support with our Year 11 children over the past few weeks of examinations.

Our children have risen to the challenge exceptionally well and we are tremendously proud of them. Year 11 are legally expected to remain on our school roll until Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

**We are however going to make alternative arrangements for Year 11 children to study from home, once the final whole cohort exam takes place on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June.**

#### **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June**

- All Year 11 children are expected in school for their **Biology exam**. Once the exam has finished (approximately 11am, however the finish time will vary depending on access arrangements), children are able to make their way home.
- **Online Learning** will be available from this point (please see 'Online Learning' below).
- Children who have a **Music exam** during the afternoon of Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June, will be expected to remain on site until this exam is completed in at approximately 3pm.

#### **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> June onwards**

- Children will be provided with online learning via MS Teams (Year 11 Remote Learning Teams). They are not required to attend school, unless they have an exam remaining.
- **AQA Spanish Writing exam** – children entered for this examination are required to attend school as normal. They will be able to leave site once this examination has concluded. Full school uniform must be worn.

#### **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> June**

- **AQA Further Maths Paper 2** – children entered for this examination are required to attend school as normal. They will be able to leave site once this examination has concluded. Full school uniform must be worn.

#### **Online Learning:**

Online Learning Provision will be made available to all Year 11 children to complete from home, from the afternoon of Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June, until their legal leaving date of Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June. This can be accessed via their MS Teams in the Year 11 Remote Learning area and will support children with their next steps in education.

#### **On Site Arrangements:**

If you would like your child to continue to attend school full-time until Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June, we will make provision for this. We do require you to confirm this in advance. If you would like your child to continue to attend school full-time until Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June, from 8.35am-3.00pm, please complete the MS Form below before Friday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2025. ### **Year 11 Leavers Assembly:**

There will be a Year 11 leavers assembly on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June. This will take place in school. Children should arrive from 9.15am, with the assembly beginning promptly at 9.30am. Once the assembly finishes, children will have an opportunity to sign shirts and say their farewells, and then will be expected to leave site by 11am.

Children are expected to wear full school uniform to this event. Any farewells to staff and children in other year groups will need to take place before Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June. There will not be an opportunity to do this on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June due to teaching commitments of staff and other year groups being in normal lessons.
