# EGSpectations

***We have a number of EGSpectations that we expect all children to follow at all times. This supports us to have a safe, calm and orderly school environment where all children can achieve.***

## **Our EGSpectations include:**

- Strong Start – We ensure EGScellence with uniform and entry to lessons.
- **EGScellent** Uniform – We expect all children to be in full uniform at all times. Our uniform is part of our identity; representing our pride and sense of belonging.
- **EGScellent** Equipment - We expect all children to be fully equipped at all times. This is essential for effective learning.
- Strong Finish - We finish every lesson strongly. We ensure EGScellent uniform and calm corridors.
- Perfect Punctuality - Children are expected to be on time, every time. The beginning of lessons are a crucial part of the learning journey. There is a clear routine/process if they arrive at lessons late.
- Manners Matter - At Ellis Guilford School, we all show respect to each other, speak kindly and act with integrity. The way we communicate matters.
- First Time, Every Time - We do the right thing, the first time, every time. Even when no-one is looking. We have integrity.
- Assembly - Assemblies are an important part of our week when we come together as a group. We behave respectfully at all times.
- Calm Corridors - We move calmly and purposefully around our school – we show respect for everyone.
- Never a Bystander - We do not expect children to engage, observe or encourage anti-social behaviour. We encourage children to act with integrity at all times, alerting adults where there is a known issue or concern.
- Precise Praise - We focus on specific elements of helpful behaviours and highlight what we want to see children demonstrate more of.
- Line-Up - We expect children to line-up quickly, silently and EGScellently after the final whistle to show we are 'ready-to-learn'.
- Family Lunch - We expect children to sit and eat together, and socialise as a cohort, demonstrating our sense of community.
