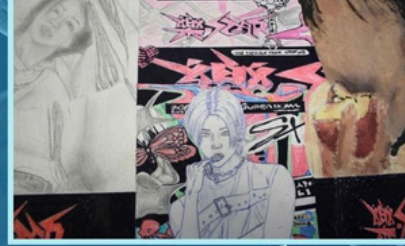

"Basketball academy - it's been great to be involved"

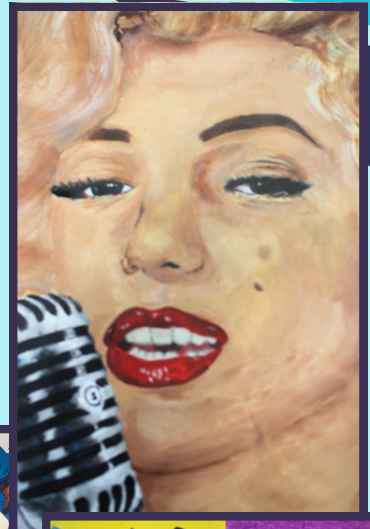


CELEBRATING OUR YOUNG CREATIVES

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SAFEGUARDING – Knife Crime and the Law

This week This week in safeguarding training, our children completed a session focusing on knife crime and the law. The session explored what the law says about carrying knives, the serious legal consequences involved, and—most importantly—how to keep themselves and others safe.

As well as important information, the focus was on knowing where to seek help or advice if they are worried about themselves or someone else, and how to report a concern in school or in the community. This training is delivered in partnership with Nottingham Police's Operation Sceptre.
