Dear Parents/Carers,

Update and guidance for w/c 12th October 2020

In line with the current guidance on self-isolation, and having contacted East Midlands Public Health, we have a number of staff who are currently having to self-isolate for the next 14 days and are therefore working from home. This means your child may not have their usual teacher for the next week however, our priority is to ensure the continuity of education for all children in our care.

I can assure parents/carers and our pupils, we will not be using any external supply for any lessons, mainly science, where your child is affected. Lessons will be set by the specialist staff and led, in the main, by members of the school's senior leadership team and other members of the school's teaching staff.

There will be occasions where pupils will have an additional PE lesson in place of one of their science lessons:

Monday, p2: Ms Anderson, Ms Tariq, Mr Waller, Ms White, Mr Walsh: Y9 pupils who have science taught by these staff at this time should wear their PE kit to school

Tuesday p4: Ms Goyal, Mr Gadsbey: Y8 pupils who have science taught by these staff at this time, should wear their PE kit to school

Tuesday p4: Ms L Cook: Y9 pupils who have science taught by these staff at this time, should wear their PE kit to school

Could I ask all Y8 and Y9 pupils check their timetables and follow the above instruction.

All other lessons for all year groups are unaffected and we should look forward to our pupils having a great final week before half term.
