### **Easter Study Sessions**

Dear Parent/Carer,

The second set of Year 11 PPEs took place recently and pupils will be receiving their working at grades and new predictions before the end of term.

#### **There are now only 24 school days left until the main examination season commences.**

As part of our package of support for Year 11 pupils this year, I am pleased to inform you that we are offering additional study sessions over the Easter holiday.

As I have explained previously, we are endeavouring to offer as much help and support to pupils as possible, and the study sessions over the holiday are another way we are able to offer additional learning time. It is therefore highly recommended that pupils attend the study session(s) where it has been offered.

Each study session will run for two hours. If pupils are attending a session, they will need to be registered onsite at the beginning of each session. **Pupils must enter school through the main reception and sign in.** Pupils must then wait in main reception to be collected by their teacher. There is no reception cover during the holidays so if pupils are late, they may not be able to enter the school site. The school does have contractors in completing building work, so it is important pupils are always with their teacher while on site and leave straight after their session has ended.

Unfortunately, there will be no lunch facilities available, so if pupils are attending both morning and afternoon sessions, they must provide their own lunch. Pupils are not expected to wear school uniform when they are in school over half-term.

Pupils must have signed up via the form by **Friday, 1<sup>st</sup> April** to help us plan for who we will be expecting.
